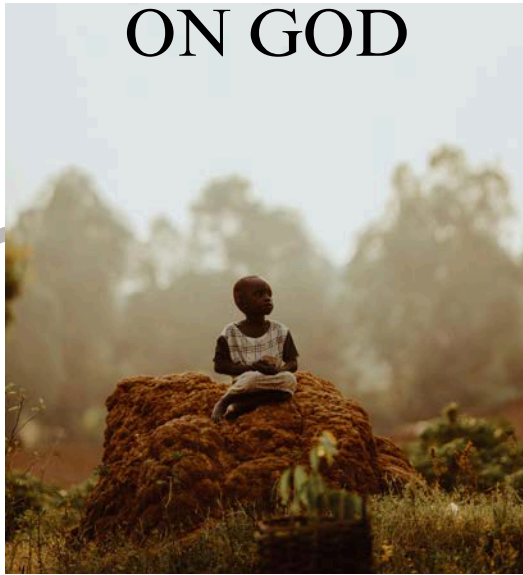

# SURRENDER OUR LIVES ON GOD



## PROVERBS 11:17

This involves making God our ultimate priority, submitting to His Lordship and aligning our daily actions with biblical principles rather than personal ambitions/worldly desires.

As much as it is a process of transition from self reliance to dependance on God ,we should live as living sacrifices to be used as His purposes considering the following factors:

### 1. Reading the scripture/Bible daily.

-It should be a self driven habit to know God's promises and commandments to us. Not just reading but apply what we learn our daily actions as they speak louder than words in **James 2:17**. By doing so; we are guarded against temptations.

### 2. Fearing and worshipping God

-Choose to praise God even in most difficult circumstances recognizing that pain can drive you closer to Him and grow spiritually.

### 3. Serving and loving

As it is one of the greatest commandments; to love our God with all our heart, soul and mind and above all love our neighbors wholeheartedly without expecting any reward **Matthew 22:36-40**. It is our duty to practice love, **1st Corinthians 13:1-10**.

“The man that wandereth out of the way of understanding shall remain in the congregation of the dead.” **Proverbs 21:16**

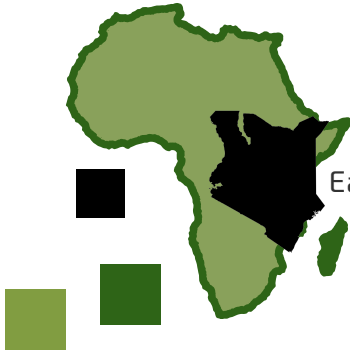
