# TALK SUBMISSION

Our faith in God and the way we serve Him needs to be seen in full view of our children. Take the Passover, for example. The people were to observe the feast of unleavened bread, the Passover meal and the consecration of the firstborn in years to come, so that they would remember the night they were brought out of Egypt.

But this was no adults-only remembrance.

Listen:

*"And when your children ask you 'What does this ceremony mean to you?' Tell them..." (Exo 12:26-27)"* *On that day tell your son, 'I do this because...'" (13:8)* *And, "In days to come when your son asks you, 'What does this mean?' say to him..." (v.14)*

Notice the insistence in these three quotes.

Whether our children ask us anything or not, we need to tell them what we are doing, and why we are doing it. "I am doing this because..."

Secondly, we also need to be able to give them the answer to "What does this mean?" What does God mean by asking us to do what we do?

And lastly, to give them a personal faith, we need to be able to answer what it means to us.

They need to know the personal reasons for our faith - not the generic "everyone does this" answer, but what does it mean to you?

If we can share our faith in God with our children this way, it will encourage them to think about what God might mean to them, and give them an opportunity to share their lives with Him.

**Exo 13:21-22** On leaving Egypt the LORD through His servant Moses led the way to the promise land.

There was light for guidance, day and night. The detailed Exodus record of the early stages of the journey to the promised land shows the LORD's care and abundant mercy (**Exo 15:13**) for Israel his firstborn son (**Exo 4:22-23**).



These details prepare the way for us to understand the significance of the words of David, Simeon, the Apostle John and the Lord Jesus Christ. Like the Israelites we always have the light of the Word of God to guide our steps to the Kingdom of God.

Are we watching, listening, walking and seeking to obey God in our way of life?

*“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path” (Psa 119:105).*

Simeon took the baby Jesus in his arms, and blessed God, and said,

*“For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel.” (Luke 2:30-32).*

*“...God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:” (1John 1:5-6).*

*“the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.*


*And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.” (Rev 21:23-24).*


