The Spread of the Truth in Coastal and Eastern Regions of Kenya

The spread of the Truth in this area did not happen by chance, but through the faithful efforts of those who dedicated their lives to the service of God. Among them was Bro. David Njeru Njoka, a man whose early commitment to the Gospel led him into missionary work that would leave a lasting impact. From humble beginnings, his work laid a foundation upon which many have come to know and understand the Truth.

Bro. David Njeru Njoka was a devoted believer and missionary from his early life. Initially, in his native area, he was a member of the A.I.C. In 1960s, he moved to Kitui and in the year 1971 he met Bro. Phillip Wekati, who at that time was a member of the Jeshi la Wokovu(Salvation Army). Sharing a common desire to preach and serve, the two came together and formed their own mission, which they called Jeshi la Mbinguni(Heavenly Army), and they went on to officially register it.



In 1972, they met a brother from the Christadelphian Bible Mission (CBM). While he acknowledged their zeal and desire to serve, he explained to them that what they were teaching was not according to the correct doctrine. This marked a turning point in their lives, as they were then taught the correct doctrine and were baptized.

From that point, the work took a more organized direction. Bro. Phillip Wekati took responsibility for preaching the Gospel in the western part of the country, while Bro. David Njeru Njoka focused on the eastern and coastal regions, continuing the spread of the Truth with renewed understanding and purpose.



Bro. David Njeru Njoka preached the Gospel widely across the coastal region, where many came to believe and were baptized into Christ. He carried out the same work in the eastern region, with many also responding to the Truth and being baptized. As a result of this faithful labor, a number of ecclesias were established in the coastal region, including Changamwe, Mikindani, and Makindu, among many others. Likewise, in the eastern region, ecclesias were established in areas such as Kitui Central and Kitui South, as the Truth continued to spread and take root in different places.

In the early 1980s, together with Bro. Phillip Wekati, they separated from the CBM and joined the Berean Christadelphians, after which he continued steadfastly in the preaching of the Gospel.

In his later years, he focused more on local preaching, and still many people came to believe. He had no boundaries when it came to sharing the Gospel—reaching out to people from different denominations, who often welcomed him to teach them the true message of the Scriptures.

Bro. David Njeru Njoka's life reflects a quiet commitment to the service of God and the sharing of the Truth. Through his efforts, many had the opportunity to hear and respond to the Gospel, and the work continues in the areas where it was first established. As we reflect on this history, we are reminded of the value of faithful service and the responsibility each of us has to continue in the same spirit, holding fast to sound doctrine and supporting the growth of the Truth in our own time.
